Vocational Education & Training In Schools (VET) Programs In The South East

What are VET Programs?

Vocational Education and Training (VET) programs broaden the range of study options available to senior secondary students. VET programs enable young people to undertake general and vocational studies.

What do VET Programs Offer?

- A NATIONALLY RECOGNISED vocational certificate with credits built in just like other subjects.
- counts towards the VCE & VCAL Certificate
- can contribute to the ATAR or study score
- Allows students to gain the VCE or VCAL and a VET qualification
- Develops general work related competencies ie, skills in communication, team work, using technology, problem solving, using mathematical ideas and concepts, planning and organising activities, gathering and analysing information and occupational health and safety
- Training in a specific industry area
- An opportunity to put your knowledge and skills into practice in a simulated or actual workplace environment known as Structured Workplace Learning.
- A nationally recognised qualification which will provide access to further training
- Improves your chances of getting work when you finish school.



The Senior Secondary Certificates in Victoria are undergoing reform. From 2023 the VCE Vocational Major will replace Intermediate and Senior VCAL and the Victorian Pathways Certificate will replace Foundation VCAL. At the time of printing this publication advice is being provided to schools regarding the implementation arrangements for the new certificates for 2023. The South East VET Cluster consists of 40 representatives from Government Schools, Catholic Schools, Independent Schools, Special Schools, private RTO's and TAFE. The cluster meets on average about seven times in an academic year.
