ABOUT SCHOOL BASED APPRENTICESHIPS AND

TRAINEESHIPS

School-based Apprenticeships and Traineeships (SBATs) are available for all secondary school students from 15 years of age.

An SBAT allows students to combine their Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE) or Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning (VCAL) with 7 hours a week of paid part-time work in their chosen industry.

Work placement times are scheduled around school timetables and industry requirements.

Students are also released from their school timetable one day each week to attend a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) where they complete their formal training.



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U Train is the Legal Employer of the **SBATs and organises the workplace** with a Host Employer.

U Train pays the trainee's wages and monitors the trainee's progress through regular visits. U Train provides the trainee with support throughout the traineeship.

VFA Learning is U Train's Registered Training Organisation (RTO) of choice and as such, is responsible for delivering the formal training component of the relevant SBAT courses within their scope of registration.

U Train has formed partnerships with a number of work places who are willing to take on students and train them in the industry.

The six industries that U Train employs SBATs are: Fitness, Early Childhood, Allied Health, Aquatics and Community Recreation, Education Support and Hospitality.

SBATs particpate in work placement with a Host Employer and learn relevant, employability skills. Successful demonstration of these skills and the industry relevant knowledge completed in the classroom leads to a nationally recognised qualification.

VFA Learning offers training out of our 3 convenient locations in the CBD, Geelong and Narre Warren. Successful completion of the traineeship also results in students receiving credits towards either their VCE or VCAL.

As well as gaining a nationally recognised qualification, students also gain valuable experience as they participate in part time employment in their chosen industry for 7 hours a week for the duration of the program.

Student entering this program will need to be job ready, have a willingness to learn and follow instructions, be flexible and committed to personal growth.
